

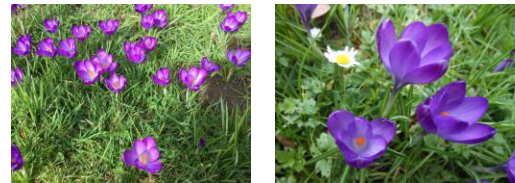
# Park Junior School
